


RECIPE

Salsa

INGREDIENTS

8-9 Roma tomatoes, cut into chunks
7-8 jalapeno peppers, remove stems and seeds
1 Tbsp granulated garlic (or crushed fresh cloves)
salt to taste

Place in pan with 1/2 cup of water. Cook about 20 minutes, until done. Cool and place in food processor with leaves from 1 small bunch of cilantro. Process until all is chopped well into a sauce.

Optional: chopped iceberg lettuce, tomatoes and onions.	1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
	1 tsp. onion powder
	Salt and pepper
Fry sauce	2 Tbsp dill pickle juice

DIRECTIONS

Heat tortillas one at a time on a hot griddle, both sides. Top with desired toppings, drizzle with fry sauce, wrap up and enjoy!

RECIPE

Tropical Getaway Cookies

INGREDIENTS

1 ½ cups flour	1-2 tsp. vanilla extract
1 tsp. baking soda	
½ tsp. salt	3 cups oatmeal
1 cup butter, room temperature	1/3 cup coconut shreds
½ cup brown sugar	1/3 cup chopped macadamia nuts
½ cup granulated sugar	1/3 cup white chocolate chips
2 eggs	

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 350°. Whisk together flour, baking soda and salt in a bowl; mix well. Cream butter and sugars in a separate bowl until smooth. Add eggs and vanilla, mix well. Add flour mixture and mix well. Stir in oats, coconut, and nuts, mix well. Drop rounded tablespoons of dough onto parchment paper lined baking sheets. Bake 10-12 minutes and cool for 1 minute before removing from pan. Enjoy!

ARE YOU ON THE LIST?

Who has time for unwanted telemarketing calls? If you have not already, you may want to register your landline and mobile phones on the National Do Not Call Registry (www.donotcall.gov). If you are already registered and are still receiving calls, you can verify your registration at the same website.

Registered numbers are removed from telemarketing and company call lists. Telemarketers must access the registry database and remove all numbers from their call lists. Unless you remove your number from the registry, numbers are on the list permanently and it does not expire.

It is easy and free to register at www.donotcall.gov or call 1-800-382-1222 from the number you want to register. It may take up to eight weeks to see a reduction in those pesky calls.

Some of you may have heard, read or watched the news cast where Triangle Communications was mentioned using Chinese equipment from a company called Huawei (pronounced wah-way). The CNN news segment claimed that companies like Triangle Communications have installed this equipment and its interference with Inter-Continental Ballistic Missiles (ICBM) managed by Malmstrom Airbase and used to track Air Force personnel by the Chinese government.

Triangle does utilize Huawei equipment in its cellular and fixed wireless networks and has done so since 2012. The equipment around the Missile silos has a fixed RF signal and is utilized for our fixed wireless internet service. It is not used in a mobile capacity and cannot interfere with any ICBM launch or track any Air Force personnel. MAKING SURE YOUR PAYMENT IS APPLIED CORRECTLY

Each day Triangle receives a large number of payments. Once the payments are opened and sorted, the bill statements accompanied by checks are run through a machine which reads the statement and the check. This process allows us to post payments to our members' accounts quickly.

Here are a few tips to making sure your payment can be processed quickly and correctly:

Enclose the payment stub with your payment.

- Please **DO NOT** staple, tape or paper clip your payment to the payment stub. Staples and tape can cause problems with the machine and those payments must be processed separately.
- If there are special instructions for your payment(s), please make note on the payment stub or write a note on a piece of paper but **DO NOT** attach to the stub.
- Please use blue or black pen. Other colors can not be read by our payment processor.
- Phone, Internet and mobile phone payments can be paid with one check, but please send the payment stubs or write all the account numbers on the memo line on your check.
- If you are paying an amount different than what is on the stub, please be sure to write the amount you want applied to the account on the stub.
- Hill County Electric payments must be paid by a separate check.

Thanks McKayla for answering all my questions and if you haven't seen it, I highly recommend Incredibles 2.


