

RECIPE

Super Fudgy Brownies

Submitted by Wanda Lucas of Moccasin, MT

INGREDIENTS

1 cup flour	2 cups sugar
1 tsp. baking powder	4 eggs
1 tsp. salt	2 tsp. vanilla
4-6 (1 oz.) squares unsweetened baking chocolate	1½ cups nuts (optional)
⅔ cup butter or margarine	

DIRECTIONS

Combine flour, baking powder and salt; set aside. Melt chocolate and butter over low heat. Stir in sugar, vanilla, eggs and flour mixture. Add nuts. Bake in a 9 x 13 pan for 25 minutes in a 350° oven.

Frost with chocolate frosting or drizzle white powdered sugar

RECIPE

Charlie's Sweetheart Pancakes

INGREDIENTS

1 cup brown kamut flour	¼ cup coconut oil
1 cup white kamut flour	½ applesauce
1 cup oat flour	1 cup almond milk
½ cup brown sugar	¼ cup lemon juice
3 tsp baking powder	1 ¾ cup water
1 ½ tsp baking soda	1 tsp pure peppermint extract
¾ tsp salt	6 oz. frozen raspberries*
¼ cup olive oil	

DIRECTIONS

In a mixing bowl, combine first 7 ingredients and mix. Set aside. In a large mixing bowl, combine the 2 oils, applesauce, milk, lemon juice, water, and peppermint extract. Stir well. Then add the flour mixture to the wet ingredients and stir until thoroughly combined. Add raspberries and stir in completely. Cook on griddle on medium-high heat, flipping and removing when a nice golden color and light and fluffy. Serve with your favorite pancake condiments or nothing at all! They are very flavorful all by themselves. ☺ Leftovers can be stored in the fridge and reheated in the oven - cover dish you reheat in with aluminum foil.

*Do not thaw or drain raspberries before adding to batter.

Note: My wife loves when I make these specialty pancakes! She says she married me for my one-of-a-kind, delicious breakfast foods. Enjoy! ☺

RECIPE

Rhubarb Cream Delight (corrected recipe)

CRUST:

1 cup flour
¼ cup sugar
½ cup butter

Mix all the above ingredients together and pat in a pie pan.

RHUBARB LAYER:

3 cups rhubarb
½ cup sugar
1 Tbsp flour

Combine rhubarb, sugar and flour. Place over crust and bake for 15 minutes at 375°.

Remove and reduce oven to 350°.

CREAM LAYER:

12 oz. cream cheese
½ cup sugar
2 eggs

Meanwhile, prepare cream layer by beating together cream cheese and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs, one at a time. Pour over hot rhubarb layer. Bake at 350° for 25-30 minutes or until almost set. Remove to a wire rack.

TOPPING:

8 oz. sour cream
2 Tbsp sugar
1 Tbsp vanilla

Beat together topping ingredients and pour over cream layer.

Chill.




